The vintage 2013, with its ruby colour and fades aromas, blends the freshness of tannic Cabernet Sauvignon to the silky Merlot. It has beautiful notes of red fruits and strawberry. Its fruity and tannic flavours are silky and fresh.





Appellation: AOC Graves Red

Village: Cérons

Surface area: 10 hectares

Geology: Mixed gravel soil with sand and small stones resting

upon a subsoil of oceanic limestone.

Blend: 50% Cabernet-Sauvignon

50% Merlot

Vineyard management: Sustainable Viticulture.

Planting density: 6,600 vines/hectare.

Harvest: Grapes are handpicked at prime maturity and

carefully sorted before being taken to the winery for

fermentation.

Winemaking: Gravity feed grape reception and production.

Fermenting time and vatting 20 days, in small

thermo regulated vats.

Ageing: Aged in cement vats 12 months along. Bottled at the

Château

Harvest date: Merlot: 24th September - 25th September

Cabernet Sauvignon: 6th October
